Free and Open Source Software (FOSS) is computer software that can be classified as both free software and open-source software. To popularize FOSS and its use through ICT, Ministry of Human Resources and Development, Government of India had launched the Spoken-Tutorial project, IIT Bombay. It is an initiative of the 'Talk to a Teacher' activity of the National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (ICT). The Spoken-Tutorial project is about teaching and learning a particular FOSS via an easy Video tool. Students are already provided with the on-line training programme of Spoken-Tutorial on selected FOSS. As students with the thorough knowledge of specific FOSS will have an edge in the job market and become entrepreneurs and use FOSS in their businesses, saving money vs., if they were using commercial software. IQAC suggested the staff members to incorporate some courses on FOSS in the curriculum. Dr. S.K. Jayanthi, Head & Associate Professor in Computer Science and Dr. R. Parvathi, Head & Associate Professor in Mathematics, had accepted to introduce FOSS as self

learning papers in their curriculum. It is planned to introduce Scilab, LaTex in Mathematics board and Python, PHP and MySQL in Computer Science board as Self Learning papers. Study materials are based on the Tutorials provided by Spoken-Tutorial, IIT Mumbai and the assessment will be done online.

The details of the Summer Research Fellowship Programme of Science Academies were elaborated by Dr. R. Parvathi. Three national science academies offer several two-month Summer Fellowships to enable students/ teachers to work with scientists associated with the three Academies during 2016. The faculty members interested in enhancing their research acumen are informed to apply for the fellowship.

The department, faculty and student details are required by the Administration for report preparation. Principal and the members discussed the issue regarding preparation of reports for University, UGC and NAAC. Departments maintain the details of events conducted like seminar, conference and special lectures, research students' details, faculty participation in conference etc. As the data are available in various departments in various forms, collecting and consolidating the details takes more time. Hence it was decided to standardize the documents and storing the details in common repository as standardization of document formats across the departments remove ambiguity and confusion. Principal suggested to conduct brain storming session among members to find out what information need to be collected from the Departments, Faculty, Students, various cells, clubs and voluntary organizations. Dr. E.S. Samundeeswari and Dr. R. Parvathi opted to take up this work. Regarding the common repository, Dr. E.S. Samundeeswari suggested to make use of Google Forms for collecting information from various stakeholders. Dr. S. Karthiga and Dr. Sabitha accepted to verify the effectiveness of the forms by inputing some sample data.
