NSS 2016-2017

The Institution takes pride in recording that there are four NSS units co-ordinated by four programming officers each with an admirable strength of 410 Volunteers.

A plethora of programs was organized by the NSS Units.

International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21.06.2016 in which more than 85 students participated.

On 26.06.2016, **International Anti-drug Day** was observed. In connection with a short story writing competition was conducted under the topic of “ **Bodhai Illa Padhai**”.

On 11.07.2016, **World Population Day** was observed. The chief guest Dr.S.Prabakar, District collector, Erode flagged off the rally and highlighted the need to create awareness on Pollution.
