## **ACTIVITIES OF COVID- 19 CELL**

- ➤ The Covid-19 Cell was established with a view to prevent Covid-19 within the Campus.
- As per the G.O (Ms)No.643, dated 13.11.2020 the Standard Operating Procedures were followed.
- Wearing of facemask, adequate usage of hand sanitizer and maintenance of social distancing were insisted and monitored by the cell. The sanitizer prepared in the college were distributed to all the Departments, Laboratories, Classrooms and in all the common areas namely Library, Canteen, Handwash areas, Restrooms etc.
- An automatic hand sanitizer equipment with sensor facility is fixed in the reception area.
- > Soap oil was also distributed within the campus.
- > Teaching, Non-Teaching and students were monitored at the Entry/Exit points and in the college buses for thermal scanning and hand sanitization.
- ➤ Closed dustbins were also placed in common areas for the disposal of used masks.
- Facial masks were also kept available in the reception desk for those who are in need of it.
- ➤ The Entire Campus was sanitized at frequent intervals.
- Frequent reminding on the prevention of Covid-19 is done through a common announcement system to maintain a healthy environment within the Institution.
- Covidshield Vaccination Camp was organized on 01.09.2021 in association with Erode Corporation for both staff and students. About 135 beneficiaries including Teaching and Nonteaching staff members and students above 18 years of age from Vellalar College for Women and other institutions of Vellalar Educational Trust got vaccinated.
- ➤ A Swab Testing Camp was organized on 15.09.2021 at Kasthurba Gandhi Auditorium. Sputum samples were collected from about 67 staff and students of Vellalar College for Women by lan technicians of Primary Health Center, Thindal and the collected samples were given for RT-PCR analysis.
- ➤ A Vaccination Camp was organized in association with Surampatti Primary Health Center, Erode on 16.09.2021. About 68 beneficiaries including Teaching and Non-teaching staff members and students above 18 years of age got vaccinated with Covishield.
